

## **Endovaginal ultrasound**

Patient ID: 123645

Patient Name: Layal Yaakoub

Age: 39

Reason for Visit: metrorrhagia with irregular bleeding.

Ultrasound Findings:

An endovaginal ultrasound was performed to evaluate the cervix and surrounding structures due to the patient's symptoms.

- Cervix: A polyp is noted in the cervical canal (col), measuring approximately 3 cm. The polyp appears smooth with a slightly lobulated surface. No signs of vascularity are observed on Doppler imaging.
- Uterus: The uterus is normal in size and echogenicity, with no focal lesions detected.
- Ovaries: Both ovaries are unremarkable in appearance, with no cysts or masses noted.
- Other Findings: No significant free fluid in the pelvic cavity.

Impression:

- A 3 cm smooth cervical polyp identified in the cervical canal. Clinical correlation is recommended, and follow-up may be necessary for further evaluation and management.
